3on3 Hockey is best described as “organized pond hockey”, where kids can develop their skills in a Summer league that emphasizes fun and competitiveness to a certain level.

The unique rules of 3on3 hockey, contribute to a fast, exciting pace. This wide-open format promotes more time with the puck and creativity amongst players of all skill levels.

To keep the emphasis on fair play and fun, there are balancing rules for equal competition when teams are made and when games are played. Our league is currently available from Novice to Pee wee ages.

RULES:

- Half /Full Ice Play
- Each team has 3 skaters and a goalie on the ice each shift.
- Whistle will indicate goals or saves, offensive team must clear the goalie area for play to resume. On a save instance, goaltender can play puck or give to teammate directly after whistle is blown.
- Minor penalties will result in a penalty shot. Puck is live if shooter does not score. If saved, offensive team must clear goalie area.
- NO offsides or icings.
- Buzzer will sound every 60 seconds for a shift change. Referee will throw a “new puck” during shift change. The “new puck” is now in play.
- No shift changes till horn blows. Player must stay on ice for complete shift, exceptions for injury or equipment malfunction will be made.
- Remember kids this is for fun, so we don't want to see any abuse of players, officials etc. We reserve the right to suspend any child from further play, if they do not abide by the essence of fair play.
- Face-offs occur at the beginning of each period at center ice.
- All coaches are required to make every effort to ensure EQUAL ICE TIME for all 3on3 participants.
